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Following points were discussed in the meeting as per the Agenda:

1. To Confirm the Minutes of last meeting held on 11th July 2025 –

Director Dr. H. U. Tiwari recited the minutes of the last College Development Committee meeting held July 11 2025. Minutes of the meeting were discussed and confirmed with the permission of the Hon' Chairman.

2. Review of Admission of First and Direct Second Year Engineering –

Director put forth data of First and Direct Second Year Engineering Admissions with cut offs. He told that all branches had almost full admission and the cut off is also continually increasing (7th in Pune Region). Hon' Shri.S.D.Garade asked about BBA & BCA courses Admissions. Director told that BCA had almost full admissions but BBA course is lagging in admissions.

3. Review of Institute Intake-

Director put forth proposed Intake of M.Tech for enlisted courses. He further added that in view of Research center Institute should have Post Graduate courses as below.

The Committee suggested to present a separate proposal considering availability of infrastructure to Trust.

4. Autonomy status –

Director put forth the Autonomy progress of the Institute; he told that Institute has made steady progress towards the implementation of autonomy through a series of planned academic and statutory activities. The process included submission of the First Year syllabus structure to SPPU, followed by Board of Studies (BoS) meetings of all departments and orientation sessions on Examination Rules & Regulations and the



autonomy framework for faculty members. Subsequently, BoS meetings for F.Y. B.Tech., BBA, and BCA were conducted along with key statutory meetings of the Board of Examination, Academic Council, and Governing Body. Further academic planning was carried out through additional departmental BoS meetings, and the SE-BE syllabus structure was also submitted to SPPU, demonstrating systematic progress in the autonomy implementation process.

5. Review of Academics, T&P, Research & other development activities –

First Year HOD Prof. Shital Patil presented the data of Applied Science and Humanities department. He told that Intake of First Year is 600 and 32 faculties working in the department. He further put forth the various students' achievements like World Cup of Dance (Kathak) Competition at Thailand and various Sports competitions. He told about faculty Research paper publication in Journals. He further told about branch wise Induction program organized for newly admitted students. HOD explained how Autonomy brought changes in conduction of academics, Examination, Evaluation, Results etc.

Hon'Shri.V.S.Kalbhor suggested to take special efforts for placement from First Year. Director assured to take necessary precautions while implementing NEP and Autonomy in the Institute from First Year.

- **Civil** HOD Dr. Sameer Sawarkar told about various students and faculty achievements. He further thanked PCET for financial support to attend a Summit (ARTS2025) in MAHSA University, Malaysia on October 29-30, 2025. He told about special efforts taken by department for Personality Development through English Read/Write/Speak Training and IKS. He told that Civil department always focus on Competitive Examinations like MPSC/UPSC/GATE as a result of that the count of selected student for Government Job was increased.

Hon'Shri.V.S.Kalbhor suggested to include modern Tools and Techniques in Syllabus while implementing Autonomy. Director told that Institute structure the syllabus as per guidelines of National Education Policy (NEP-2020) which already included permutation combination of new things together considering overall development of Students.

- **Mechanical** HOD Dr.Gulab Siraskar told about various students and faculty achievements. He told about various activities conducted by the department like Industrial visit to Katraj Dairy, Advik Hi-tech Pvt. Ltd. Chakan and KSB Pump At Vambori, Ahmednagar. He added that student going to higher study increased in Mechanical



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improved and added that German language training would help for placement in European Countries.

- **E&TC** HOD put forth various students' achievement and he told about special Award in SAE Aerothon 2025 (Drone Competition). He told about various activities conducted by the department like Industrial visit to KVK Baramati, Diya Electronics. He further told about various achievements by faculties like Product developed by Dr.Rahul Mapari - An Intelligent Biometric Operated Firearm, Paper and Book published by faculties. He further thanked PCET to giving opportunity to attend 'Sakal Educon' in Landon.
- **Computer** HOD Dr.Vijay Kotkar told about various activities conducted by the department like Expert Sessions of LaTeX, GRE and TOEFL, Google Cloud Agent AI Day Hackathon, GRE & TOEFL one to one Guidance Session, Web Development Workshop. He also told about Industrial visit of students at Software Technology Park of India, Hinjewadi, GMRT, Khodad, Narayangaon. He further told about Expert sessions and workshop organized by department and also added various students and faculty achievements. He said that ten Research proposal submitted by faculties for Government funding.
- **IT** HOD Dr.Santoshkumar Chobe told about various students and faculty achievements. He told about new record of filling 78 copyrights in a single day by faculties and students. He further told about a National level Hachathon organized by the department.
- **BCA** HOD Dr.Smriti Pathak put forth various achievements of students and faculties. She further told about various activities conducted by the department like Intellect quiz competition, Zumba workout session, Best out of Waste activity. She explained how faculties were using Innovative and creative tools like video based learning, flipped classroom, activity based learning in teaching learning process.
- **BBA** HOD Dr.Smriti Pathak put forth various activities conducted by the department like Inaugural function of Innovation club, Youth parliament, pre-placement preparation, Yoga Session, Cyber Crime session, NSS-Tree plantation and garbage collection. She further told about various achievements of faculties and students.
- **T&P** – Dr.S.A.Rawandale put forth key achievements and placement details of 2024-25 batch. He also told about various activities conducted by T&P Cell and Alma Connect Portal for Alumni Association. Director said that Aptitude training of students was fully sponsored by the Institute.



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Director put forth various staff development activities of all departments and National level Sports achievements of students.

6. Fee proposal submitted to Fees Regulating Authority (FRA), Revised Budget – 2025-26 and Expenses incurred till 31st October 2025 –

Director told that fees proposal has been submitted to Fees Regulating Authority (FRA) for the year 2026-27 with same fees as of 2025-26. He also put forth the revised budget of 2025-26 and expenses incurred till 31st October 2025. All committee members review the revised budget and expenses. Dr.G.N.Kulkarni suggested to increase the budget of Research & Development and student development head in revised budget. Hon' Shri.V.S.Kalbhor asked to revise the budget and do possible changes in it.

7. Any other point with the permission of Honorable Chairman –

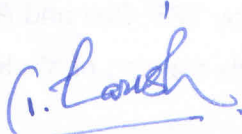

He also put forth the theme of seed funding for R&D activities and R&D Excellence Award. He further added that adequate budget allocated to R&D activities. Hon' Shri.S.D.Garade suggested to implement the same R&D policy as PCCoE.

Director put forth following point for discussion –

1. Research Center – Director said Institute should have Research Center, Hon' Shri.D.P.Landge told to send separate proposal for discussion.
2. Proposed Solar Power plant 50 KW (30 Lakh) – Director put forth the proposal of Solar Power plant of 50 KW amounting 30 lakh. Hon' Shri.V.S.Kalbhor told to consider it in next financial year.
3. SPPU- Best College Award application – Director told that Institute has applied for Best College Award of Savitribai Phule Pune University, all committee members expressed best wishes for the same.

Dr.S.A.Rawandale put forth Inter Collegiate Cricket competition of PCET Institute, Hon' Shri.S.D.Garade suggested him to initiate the same.
