Objectives of the Students' Development Cell

1. Propose various schemes of Board of Students' Development (BSD), Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU) and ensure effective implementation of these schemes once approved by BSD, SPPU

Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil Earn & Learn Scheme

Our College runs the Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil Earn & Learn Scheme for needy students. This scheme is sponsored by the Board of Students' Development, Savitribai Phule Pune University. Under this scheme students are helped financially by providing them opportunity to work at various labs and places like library, etc. and are paid for their services. Thus they help in the various tasks of the college and at the same time earn money for themselves.

Each year, we provide an opportunity for 20 to 25 students to work for the Earn & Learn Scheme during the academic year. Students learn professional skills and at the same time understand the value of money.



Students' Counseling Cell

Student Counseling Cell– Objectives:

1. The main objective of the Students' Counseling Cell is to provide counselling to students. This is necessary as students at a young age face many problems, personal and related to studies. It is necessary that students discuss these problems with a trained counsellor, so that they learn to solve the problems, and also that these problems do not affect the mental and physical health of the students
2. Along with the above, it is also necessary for students, to learn basics of personality development, professional communication, interviews, etc. which they are going to face in the future.
3. Along with the problems of students, the various staff like the teaching and non teaching, as well as other staff, face many problems, personal as well as professional, like time management, working with colleagues, and workload. To tackle all this, the services of a counsellor is very helpful.

Students' Mentoring System

To resolve day to day problems faced by students, Mentoring system has been introduced by the Institute to establish a better and effective student-teacher relationship. This is the continuous and consistent process till the end of the UG programme of the student. For each 25 to 30 students, mentors are allotted which communicate on regular basis with the students. Mentors conduct meetings with students to resolve their problems related to academics, personal and professional matters. Mentor meetings are conducted once every month and records are maintained. Issues raised, if any, are discussed with HoD through mentor coordinator.

About the Art Circle:

The Art Circle at PCCOER was initiated to enhance fine arts such as Drawing, Painting, Sketching, Writing, Literature, Culture, Traditions, and other Global Art forms. These forms of art are reinstalled through Elocutions, debates, films, theatre and others to boost their inherent skills in performance. Performing Arts like Dramatics, Dance and Singing are encouraged to unwind and develop a healthy mode life through the joy of performance. Traditional festivals develop, enrich and foster oneness amongst the students through exhibitions and workshops. The Art Circle encourages student participation in inter college, intra college, State, National and International Competitions to put into effect their endowments.



National Service Scheme

The National Service Scheme, NSS Unit was established in the year 2015. The NSS Unit contains 50 volunteers from all years. The aim of the NSS Unit is to inculcate sense of national pride through social service. For this the NSS unit undertakes various initiative through the students volunteers, like, cleanliness drives through Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan, blood donation drives, awareness drives during the NSS camp, in villages regarding various government schemes. The NSS Unit has also undertaken adoption and development of villages under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan Scheme.
